No appointments. Come as early as possible so you can read with other actors in various scenes. All auditions will be cold reads from the script. You must have lots of energy and not be afraid to "look silly". Must be able to learn simple choreography. NO children please.

Characters:

Jack - Late teens to early 20's. Adventurous, kindhearted, with his head in the cloudsWidow Twankey - 30 plus. Loves Jack, but often frustrated by her son, worried about moneyGertrude Grabbit - 30 plus. Scheming landlady

Mario - Any age. One half of the comic duo, like that "other Mario"

Luigi - Any age. One half of the comic duo, like that "other Luigi", sweet on Twankey

Old Lady - Any age. Fairy Godmother in disguise

Jill/Princess Peach - Late teens to early 20's. Giant's housekeeper with a secret past

Nobblenosher - Any age. The Giant. Big, mean and nasty

Claribelle - Any age. May require two people. A cow with personality

November 18, 19, 25, 26, December 1, 2. One Friday night show, two afternoon shows on Saturdays and Sundays.

Rehearsals

Start the first week of October. Tuesday and Thursday night, Sunday afternoon.
